

NCLB - PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE (PSC) - Title I

- Title I is the federal government's compensatory education program authorized in the **No Child Left Behind Act of 2001**. As part of the **No Child Left Behind Act**, the California Department of Education has identified the Title I schools listed below as Program Improvement (PI) based on the school not meeting AYP targets for two consecutive years.
- Public School Choice (PSC) gives parents whose children attend PI schools the option to transfer to a Non-PI school, including Non-PI Charter schools. District-paid transportation is provided, (based upon District guidelines, see page 2) to students who have enrolled in the PSC program.
- Priority for PSC applications must be given to the "lowest achieving children from low income families."
- For PSC information, please call (213) 241-6572.
- If your child participates in the PSC program, your child will no longer be eligible for free Supplemental Educational Services.
- **If your child is enrolled in a school listed below, he/she is eligible to apply for the PSC program.**

2010-2011 SCHOOLS AT-RISK FOR PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT (PI)

- The following Title I schools have been designated by the California Department of Education (CDE) as a school at risk for being identified as Program Improvement (PI). If the school does not meet its AYP target based on Spring 2010 academic testing, the school may be identified for PI when data is reported by CDE in Fall 2010.
- The District offers Public School Choice (PSC) to parents of all students enrolled in a PI school with district-paid transportation provided, (based upon District guidelines, see page 2).
- If you wish for your child to transfer to a Non-PI school, including Non-PI Charter schools, please submit the application for PSC.
- Priority for PSC applications must be given to the “lowest achieving children from low income families,” including Non-PI Charter schools.
- Should CDE not identify your child’s school for PI, he/she will not be eligible by law for a PSC transfer to a Non-PI school, and you will be notified accordingly.
